SAT PROGRAM

Elite's SAT Program consists of a weekly practice test and three lecture classes covering Reading, Math, and Writing. In the lecture classes, students review the practice test with experienced instructors and continue their learning through a series of lessons containing exercises designed to develop their reading, math, grammar, and writing skills. Students meet for a total of 8.5 hrs. per week—each weekly class meets for 4.5 hrs. and the practice test lasts for 4 hrs.

SPEECH & DEBATE PROGRAM

Students will focus on their use of evidence and research, as well as learning how to approach targeted audiences.
