What is Quad?

The Quad 3-2-1 Learning System is essentially an academic mentorship whose purpose is to mentor and motivate students for their academic and holistic success. It is a study group of up to three students and one instructor that meets for two hours every session to learn and develop knowledge and study skills necessary to improve and excel in specific subject matters in school or on standardized exams.

Structure

A Quad session is a minimum of two hours per session per subject. Students must make a minimum commitment of four sessions.

A minimum of four sessions is required so that the instructor has enough time with each student to adequately assess and effectively develop each student's academic needs and study patterns.
